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Guy Bates Post made his profession-debut in this city as a member of the Broadway Theatre Company, his wife, Sarah Truax, being a member of the same organization. They opened at the Third Avenue Theatre in the fall of 1887 in repertoire. In the following March Mr. Post played at the uptown house with Jane Coombe, and in October, 1888, he played at the Seattle with the Henderson Company. His appearance here last season as Steve in "The Virginian" is remembered by all.

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Jane Peyton, now with "The Heir to the Hurrah," was here a year ago as the leading woman with Lawrence D'Orsay in "The Earl of Pawtucket." Louise Rutter, now in "The Hurrah" Company, was here last season with "The Bonnie Brier Bush," and before that with "Rudolph and Adolph."

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
